III. Citizenship: A good citizen is an active participant who makes a positive contribution to the atmosphere and work of the class. Classroom Behavior Requirements

- 8. The hall pass for emergencies only. Hall pass use is monitored, and excessive use may result in lowing of citizenship grade.

Consequences of below average citizenship, besides lowered citizenship grade, include:

- Verbal warning/discussion after class
- Student call to parent at home or at work to describe an inappropriate behavior
- Paper Pick-up (nutrition break or lunch)
- Referral to your counselor or an Assistant Principal
